- ❖ Gamma Nu has signed up to be a Luminary Club for April 3, 2020 Relay for Life Event. At this point, the Relay for Life Event has been postponed.
- ❖ We can still make a significant difference with our purchases of Luminaries! Our goal is \$500 and as of now we have received \$622. Let's see if we can add another \$128 to our goal. If everyone purchases one more luminary we will get to our new goal.
- ❖ Luminary forms must reach the Luminary Team by March 28 to be credited to the Gamma Nu Luminary Club Team.
- ❖ The minimum price for luminaries purchased by <u>March 28 is \$10</u>. The price increases to \$15 after that date.
- We are asking everyone to order luminaries online at the secure Relay website: www.relayforlife.org/bayareatx.
- Just go to the website, scroll down, and select the box which says: Luminaria.
- Under Whose Relay Fundraising efforts will your donation support? Select "Team".
- Type Gamma Nu Luminary Club in the box and click <u>Search.</u>
- **Click on our team name when it appears.**
- **❖** Select the type of luminaria you want to order (only one name per luminary) and then Personalize your luminaria.
- Under "What would you like to say?" please put only "From" and your name or the person it is from.
- Order additional Luminaria or click "Next". When you are finished, go to payment information.
- **Solution** Follow the instructions for payment.
