- The minimum price for a white luminary is \$10. After the deadline, the price increases to \$15. "In Memorial: names received <u>before the deadline</u> will be placed on the Memorial Wall.
 - This year we are asking everyone to order their luminaries online. You can order them at <u>www.relayforlife.org/bayareatx</u> which is a secure website. Just go to the website, scroll down, and select the box which says: Luminaria.
 - o Under Whose Relay Fundraising efforts will your donation support? Select "Team".
 - Type Gamma Nu Luminary Club in the box and click Search.
 - Click on our team name when it appears.
 - Select the type of luminaria you want to order (only one name per luminary) and then Personalize your luminaria.
 - Under "What would you like to say?" please put only "From" and your name or the person it is from.
 - Order additional Luminaria or click "Next". When you are finished, go to payment information.
 - Follow the instructions for payment.
- All Luminary purchases will be done with a credit card.
- Be sure to write "Gamma Nu Luminary Club" in the "credit to..." box at the bottom of the form. Purchase a luminary for Relay 2021 and help the Gamma Nu Luminary Club "Light up the Track"!
- Last year our goal was \$500 and we collected \$1,001! Can we beat \$1,001 this year? Of course we can!!!
