### 2022 Gamma Nu Chapter Achievement Award

Each year the Membership/Achievement Committee of Gamma Nu Chapter selects an outstanding member of the organization to receive our Chapter Achievement Award. A gold rose guard pin is presented to this member, who is selected using the following criteria listed in our chapter by-laws.

This one-time award is given annually to a member who

- ...has been a member of Gamma Nu a minimum of five years
- ...has been an active member attending meetings at the local, area,

and/or state level.

- ...has made significant contributions in the chapter and its projects.
- ...has held two leadership positions as an officer or committee chairman.

The recipient of this year's chapter achievement award undeniably meets all these criteria. Our honoree is a 1972 graduate of Goose Creek Consolidated Independent School District Ross S. Sterling High School. After graduating from high school our honoree attended Lamar University where she earned a Bachelor of Science in Education. In 1976, our honoree embarked on her very first teaching position. Her career would last some thirty-two years, where she made a measurable impact on students in Dayton ISD, Whitney ISD, Hull-Daisetta ISD, and Hardin ISD. During her tenure as a teacher our honoree was recognized as District Teacher of the Year in two different districts. After retiring our honoree continued to serve our community by working with children at Cedar Bayou Grace UMC Day School from 2009 to 2017. In 2018, our beloved honoree returned to Goose Creek CISD where her early years of learning began to serve our current students by providing accelerated instruction. Our honoree has been a positive force within our organization and has been instrumental in leaving a remarkable impact on the field of education worldwide. Her most prestigious accomplishment is becoming the mother of Rhett, wife of Mike for 44 years, mother-in-law to Miranda, and most importantly is being Nana to John Andrew, Ella, and Ethan.

Initiated into Gamma Nu in 1982, our honoree has served in various roles. Our honoree has served previously as Chapter President for six terms, thus exemplifying her commitment to the organization and to the field of education. In 2006, she served as the Convention Co-Chair. Her other leadership roles included her being the Area Coordinator from 1998-2000, State Program Committee Co-Chair in 2000, and other various positions that have contributed to the success of Gamma Nu. This honoree has exemplified all the attributes of an outstanding member by being dedicated and committed to the organization. She has shown her loyalty to her Gamma Nu sisters and her community over these years.

In recognition of her outstanding service and contributions to Gamma Nu Chapter, Delta Kappa Gamma Society International, the Achievement Committee proudly presents the 2022 Gamma Nu Chapter Achievement Award to an outstanding member, Pam Ansley.
